

Allergies in Anaesthesia Module

Allergies are shown in the Patient Banner Bar of the Anaesthesia Module.



In Anaesthesia module:

- No pop-up warning appears if a medication is still administered despite the patient being allergic to it. Anaesthesia module does not perform the same interaction checking as PowerChart.
- No warning appears if this medication might have been administered recently pre-operatively. Anaesthesia module does not have the same minimal interval checking alert feature as PowerChart.

If a medication is selected for administration within Anaesthesia that the patient has an allergy documented against, a **red circle** appears in the top left hand corner of the medication administration window.
